Planning Organization (CAMPO)**

Will Conley

Will Conley is a small business owner, husband and father, and is serving his second term as Hays County Commissioner.

Described as “an effective leader with a vision” by the Austin American-Statesman, Will has championed limited but effective government by cutting taxes, eliminating waste, and reforming Hays County’s regulatory culture to promote homegrown small businesses and local job creation.

Since taking office, Will’s disciplined financial leadership has placed Hays County on its strongest financial footing in history by tripling the county’s savings from \$10 million to \$30 million and achieving one of the highest credit ratings available to a county government.

Will has never voted to increase the tax rate and authored some of the largest tax cuts in Hays County history. In their first year, the Conley homestead exemptions saved an average of 14% for senior citizens and 25% for disabled citizens on their property tax bills. He spearheaded the first major road and infrastructure upgrade in more than 50 years, and personally negotiated a partnership with the State of Texas to build roads at a fraction of their cost.

In recognition for his energetic, conservative leadership, Governor Perry appointed Will to serve as Commissioner of a state juvenile board. He also won the respect of his peers in local government, who elected him to chair the Capitol Area Council of Governments and Capitol Area Regional Transportation Planning Organization.

Commissioner Conley is owner and president of Conley Enterprises, an auto services business that he opened in 2001, at age 23. He is active in several local civic organizations, including the Hays County Food Bank, Crime Stoppers, Lion’s Club, Ducks Unlimited, and Texas State University Alumni Association. He is also a member of the National Rifle Association and National Federation of Independent Business.

Commissioner Conley and his wife, Erin, reside in the Wimberley Valley with their two children, Eve and Abram.
