Paul Workman filled the speaker's spot in lieu of Michael Baselice who could not attend our May meeting.

Our State Representative had just come back from the State Convention in Dallas. He said that we had 8000 delegates making it the largest gathering of Republicans in the USA.. 155 delegates were elected to go to the National Convention (104 for Ted Cruz, 48 for Donald Trump and 3 for Marco Rubio). During the State Convention Tom Mechler was re-elected as the Texas Republican Party chairman. Cindy Clark was re-elected as the Vice-Chair and Randan Steinhouser was elected SREC for Senatorial District 24. Robin Armstrong and Toni Ann Dashiel were re-elected as the National Committee members representing Texas.



During the State Convention the party rules and platform were discussed. There were some rule modifications targeted to "misbehaving" county chairmen. As for the platform is too large and complicated with 266 planks. When delegates tried to modify planks a call to cut off debates was placed and the yes votes won. They voted on every plank individually with a scantron card. All planks were passed.

Paul also mentioned the great lunch given by the Texas Federation of Republican Women where his wife, Sherry Workman was one of the honorees in this Tribute to Women Lunch.

Among the many speakers at the convention was Dinesh D'Souza who spoke about his experience in jail. As reported by Breitbart News *"In addition to his five-year probation sentencing and eight months of confinement in a community confinement center — or restitution center, which will likely be completed in San Diego, California where D'Souza resides — Judge Berman ordered D'Souza to undergo 'therapeutic counseling.'*" D'Souza also spoke about his new movie "Hillary's America: The Secret History of the Democratic Party".

The motto of the State Convention was Unite to Win. This upcoming election will be critical because the new president will be appointing at least three Supreme Court Justices.

We as Republicans need to support the Republican nominee.
